Driving North on I5

Take exit 182 for I405 S/ WA 525 N toward Mukilteo
Keep left at the fork to continue toward WA 525 N and merge onto WA 525 N
Take the Mukilteo-Clinton Ferry to Clinton (WA 525)
Upon leaving the ferry continue to follow WA 525 N,
You will turn right to stay on WA 525 N,
Turn left at Campbell Rd,
Turn left at Cultus Bay Rd,
Take the 1st right onto Campbell Rd take the 2nd left onto Old Pietila Rd.

Driving South on I5

Take the freeway exit onto WA 526 toward Mukilteo
Follow 526, it will become 84th St. SW.
Take a right at WA 525N toward the Clinton Ferry
Take the Mukilteo-Clinton Ferry to Clinton (WA 525)
Upon leaving the ferry continue to follow WA 525 N,
You will turn right to stay on WA 525 N,
Turn left at Campbell Rd,
Turn left at Cultus Bay Rd,
Take the 1st right onto Campbell Rd take the 2nd left onto Old Pietila Rd.
